The goal of this project is to send Lamin Sanyang to post-secondary school for 3 years so he can learn a trade to support his family of seven. This specific project is focused on the first school year of 2016 / 2017.

At 24 years of age, Lamin Sanyang is the head of his household. He lives with 5 younger siblings and his mother in Gambia, West Africa. Employment is hard to find for a high school graduate in The Gambia. With no source of income and a family of seven – one thing becomes very clear: without further education, this family is destined to continue a pattern of day to day survival.

Instead of treating the symptoms of poverty, will you help us solve the problem? With proper education Lamin will learn a trade that will enable him to support his family. This is the only way to break the cycle of poverty. (See our other projects to keep his younger siblings in school until Lamin and his sister Binta are employed.)

Will you help us send Lamin to school to accomplish the following?
Course: Architectural Draughtsmanship
Length: This fundraising project is for the 1st year of 3 years total

Coordinator Keith J. Clark has been communicating directly with Lamin almost daily for over a year and a half. This project is closely managed for accuracy and is completely transparent and genuine. Documentation of expenses is required from Lamin, as well as full accountability for all funds during the length of this project.

There are ZERO administrative costs or fees associated with this project - every dollar/euro goes directly to the family for this specific purpose. BetterPlace.org is FREE

There are NO administrative fees. All contributed time, effort, and love is FREE

The funds and bank account are managed by E4IL. Every penny is accounted for and goes directly to the project.

E4IL already provides funds directly to the family bi-weekly for food, a cell phone, and enough electricity to charge one phone (used primarily for communication) and two light bulbs (limited use).

This is a Non-Profit effort, a Labor of Love. E4IL is NOT a registered 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. (The cost is unjustified)

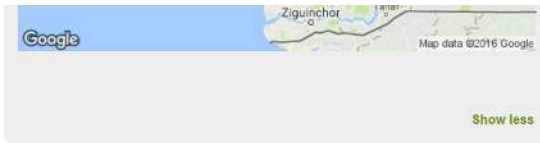
